

“Five days Capacity Building Training programme for Govt. Analyst/ Technical Personnels of Central/ States/ UTs ASU&H Drug testing laboratories”

Pharmacopoeia Commission for Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy (PCIM&H), Ghaziabad, Ministry of Ayush, Govt. of India has convened a 05 days Capacity Building Training Programme from 29.05.2023 to 02.06.2023 for Govt. Analysts & Technical personnel of Central/States/UTs Drug Testing Laboratories. In all 15 Scientists/Govt. Analysts of State Ayush Drug Testing Laboratories from Chhattisgarh, Guwahati, Mizoram, Maharashtra, Shillong and Odisha participated in the Training programme which was inaugurated by Dr. Sangeeta A.
