## BACKGROUND

Pharmacopoeia Commission for Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy (PCIM&H) is an autonomous organisation under Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India with a primary mandate of publishing Pharmacopoeias and Formularies for drugs/formulations used in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani (ASU) and Homoeopathy (ASU&H) systems of Medicine. The Commission serves as an umbrella organisation for Ayurvedic Pharmacopoeia Committee (APC), Siddha Pharmacopoeia Committee (SPC), Unani Pharmacopoeia Committee (UPC) and Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia Committee (HPC). Pharmacopoeial Laboratory for Indian Medicine (PLIM) and Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeial Laboratory (HPL) are its supporting structures.

### VISION

To be an institution of excellence for the development of regulatory standards of Ayurvedic, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathic (ASU&H) drugs

### MISSION

To promote and preserve the well-being of humans and animals in India, by bringing out official standards for quality of drugs included in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathy systems of Medicine used by AYUSH professionals and Consumers

### OBJECTIVES

1. Publication and revision of the Ayurvedic, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia of India at suitable intervals and of such addenda or supplementary compendia during the intervening periods as may be deemed necessary; releasing the publications for public use from a date when they are to become official.
2. Publication and revision of the Ayurvedic, Siddha and Unani Formularies of India, Homoeopathic Pharmaceutical Codex at regular intervals with a view to make it an authentic source of information on rational combination and use of medicines including their methods of preparation, therapeutic indications, adverse reactions, contra-indications, drug-drug interactions and similar issues concerning Indian medicines for safe use in humans and animals.
3. To nurture and promote awareness of quality in Ayurvedic, Siddha and Unani drugs/formulations, Homoeopathic pharmacopoeia as well as Homoeopathic Pharmaceutical Codex and drug research on ASU products and publish regularly or at suitable intervals other related scientific information as authorized under the rules and procedures of the Commission.
4. Exchange information and interact with expert committees of the World Health Organisation and other international bodies with a view to harmonize and develop the Ayurvedic, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeial standards to make those internationally acceptable.
5. Arranging studies either under its own auspices or through collaboration with other institutions to develop standards and quality specifications for identity, purity and strength of raw materials and compound formulations and to develop Standard Operating Procedures for the process of manufacture included or to be included in the Ayurvedic, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia/formulary and its addenda or supplementary compendia or other authorized publications.
6. Maintain National repository of authentic reference raw materials used in the manufacture of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homeopathic medicines for the purpose of reference and supply of reference standards to the stake holders at a price.

7. To assign responsibilities described for Pharmacopoeial Laboratory for Indian Medicine and Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia Laboratory under the Drugs & Cosmetics Act.
8. Generate and maintain repository of chemical reference marker compounds of the plants or other ingredients used in standardizing Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homeopathy medicines and supply them as reference standards to the stake holders on price.
9. Furtherance of the provision of Chapter IVA of Drugs & Cosmetic Act, 1940 in case ASU drugs & 4A of Schedule II of Drugs & Cosmetics Act in case of Homoeopathy medicine and rules there under related to Ayurvedic, Siddha and Unani drugs and Homoeopathy medicine respectively.
10. Acting as a coordinating centre for analytical laboratories, industry and academia by encouraging exchange of scientific and technical information and staff and by undertaking sponsored funded research as well as consultancy projects.
11. Organising national/international symposia, seminars, meetings and conferences in selected areas from time to time and to provide updated regular training to the regulatory authorities and stake holders.

### AIM OF THE WORKSHOP:

PCIM&H is organising a one-day "National Seminar on Scope and Challenges in Developing Pharmacopoeial Standards for ASU&H Drugs", aimed at gathering from Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathy drug industry/manufacturers, drug regulators of ASU&H Medicine, Research Organisations/ Councils/ Institutes/ Academia involved in Research, Development and Standardisation of ASU&H drugs and enforcement/ implementation of quality standards prescribed by Pharmacopoeias/ Formularies of respective ASU&H systems of Medicine.

Under Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules thereunder, ASU&H Pharmacopoeias and Formularies represented by their parts and volumes are the books of standards for substances included therein and such standards are official. As of now, Ayurvedic Formulary of India (Part I-III) consists of 985 Formulations, Siddha Formulary of India (Part I-II) consists of 399 Formulations and National Formulary of Unani Medicine (Vol. I-VI) consists of 1229 formulations, while monographs on 645 Single drugs and 202 Formulations of Ayurveda, 139 Single drugs of Siddha, 298 Single drugs and 202 Formulations of Unani and 1117 drugs/mother tinctures of Homoeopathy have been published.

Aim of the seminar is to explore the Scope and Challenges in Developing ASU&H Pharmacopoeial Standards. Experts in field of ASU&H Pharmacopoeias, Officials from M/o AYUSH as well as PCIM&H will interact with the gathering to enlighten them about necessity and utility of ASU&H Pharmacopoeias, Formularies etc. and also to take note of challenges faced by end users while implementing/complying to the directives of Government. This will also facilitate to create awareness regarding testing guidelines/procedures, adoption of general guidelines included in Pharmacopoeias and Formularies of ASU&H systems, among the stakeholders (Industry / Regulators / Technical Personnel) for regulatory compliance of these standards and prescribed guidelines published in the ASU&H pharmacopoeias.
