Key mandate of PCIM&H is to develop Pharmacopoeial standards for Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathy (ASU&H) Drugs and to act as Central Drug Laboratory cum Appellate Lab for ASU&H Drugs. Apart from this PCIM&H also imparts Capacity building training programme to the different stakeholders viz Drug regulators/Enforcement Authorities, Quality control / Technical personnel of ASU&H Drugs manufacturers & Ayush accredited States / UTs Drug testing laboratories, Faculty (Pharmacy) of ASU&H Colleges, Govt. Analysts / Scientist of ASU&H Govt. Drug testing laboratories and other Scientific Institutes.

PCIM&H is convening a Training programme for the above stakeholders, from 23.09.2024 to 27.09.2024.

For attending the programme each participant has to remit Rs. 5000/- as ‘Training fee’ which will be payable through NTRP (www.bharatkosh.gov.in) before the commencement of the training programme.

PCIM&H has a guest house which has limited number of rooms, hence the rooms will be allotted on first come first - serve basis.

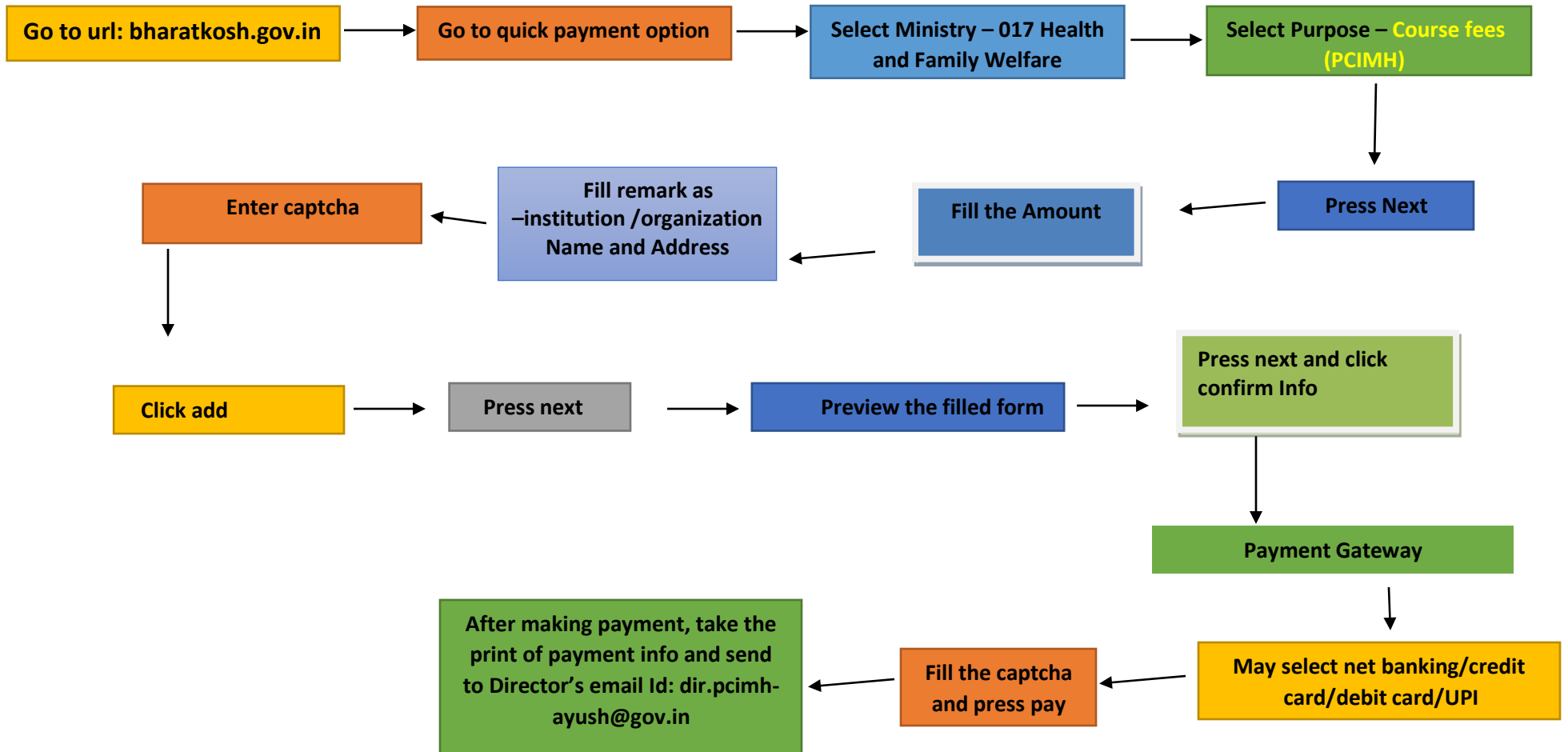
